10. The school's behaviour policy is fair and consistently used	89% of parents agreed that the school's behaviour policy is fair and consistently used. 11% of parents do not feel that the behaviour policy is fair and consistently used.
11. The school teaches my child strategies to maintain a good level of mental health	89% of parents agreed that the school teaches their child to maintain a good level of mental health. 5.5% of parents are unsure. 5.5% of parents disagree.
12. The school encourages my child to aspire, make good career choices and understand what they need to do to succeed	97% of parents agreed that the school encourage their child in these areas. 3% of parents disagreed.

13. I feel involved in my child's education	97% of parents agreed that they were involved in their child's education. 3% of parents disagreed.
14. The school have offered me the opportunity to learn about E-Safety and how to keep my child safe when using the internet	89% of parents agreed that they have been offered support on how to keep their child safe. 11% of parents disagreed.
15. When my child is ill or injured, the school acts promptly and appropriately with the situation	92% of parents agreed that the school act appropriately. 8% of parents disagreed.
16. The school is kept clean and well resourced	100% of parents agreed that the school is kept clean and well resourced.
17. When my child is taken on a school visit, I am confident that the procedures in place keep my child safe	100% of parents agreed that they feel the procedures in place keep their child safe when on a school visit.
18. I feel confident and able to report any concerns about my child's safety	100% of parents feel confident to report any concerns around their child's safety.
19. The school controls access to the school during the day, preventing unauthorised people entering the building	100% of parents feel that the school controls access to the school, preventing unauthorised people entering the building.
