

Comments from Parents/Carers: Areas we could improve.

October 2022

- It's been a trickier start this year
- Struggling with some boys in class and also amount of restricted games
- He wants to do more playing and less work.
- I don't know who to contact in case of concerns apart from the main office.
- I don't know if my child knows what to do if there is a fire.
- I can't recall when they last discussed a fire drill and practicing leaving the classroom.
- Incident in year 4 last year, a child had a camera watch and took photos of others whilst changing for PE. I felt it wasn't appropriately shared with parents. If only as an exercise as 2 weeks later another child did the same thing. Maybe parents didn't understand and the safeguarding risk. How do we know what pictures these kids took? And where are they now?
- I don't think I have been offered to learn e-safety although I could have missed it.
- Website offers info. More info on year groups, teachers set for more age appropriate age. What are their aims/awareness/teaching.
- On the whole I agree that if ill or injured school acts promptly and appropriately. Incident last year my child hurt arm at last play. I was not called early enough leaving my daughter in pain for longer than was necessary. After visit to A & E she had a chipped Radial head on right arm. I would have arrived 15min earlier if told.
- I would like to see more after school clubs not just external providers offering chargeable activities.
- Feedback is the toilets in year 5 and 6 are messy. In year 4 the girl's toilet had a hole in the door where the lock was.
- As far as I Know. Sadly I have not been able to have a proper look around due to Covid when he started so I have only been in a few rooms.
- Would be good to be notified of school procedures when on trips.
- Although our contact with class teacher is strong, we find the first point of contact at the Main School Reception very unapproachable and severe in manner.

- Bell tower is still usually open when parents are around.
- I was not a fan of Talk Communities Hub being in school.
- I know the school has been locked down during the day but has this been tested.
- Bullying varies according to the teacher.
- Lack of clubs, wrap around care outside of school, sports.
- I would like the opportunity to talk about playtimes and how the children are encouraged to be active and play games.
- School and staff are fantastic compared to other schools. It would be good to have some afterschool clubs and some holiday clubs.
