We teach you how to recognise risks in different situations and how to protect yourselves and stay safe.



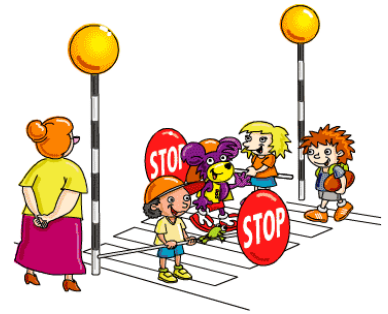
## How will we try to protect you?
