Launch of Our Aspiration Curriculum Days

We are very excited to share that we will be holding our first Aspiration Curriculum Day on Friday 17th October.

The Aspirations Curriculum is St Paul's C of E Primary School's answer to giving our pupils the best possible knowledge regarding what jobs might be available to them in the future. We hope that by looking at different jobs, researching famous people in their trades, bringing in speakers from these industries and having a go at role playing some of the roles, children will be inspired to work hard so that they can become what they want to be in the future.

We will be holding an Aspiration Curriculum day once every term, for a full day. Each term has a different job focus.

On the day we will study what the job entails, listen to a speaker, look at different role models and link the job to the wider community and how it can contribute to our role as a global citizen. The children will aim to produce a double page spread in their Aspiration Curriculum Journal which moves through school with them so that when they leave us, they have a record of all the roles they have looked at throughout their time at St Paul's.
