Techniquet - Cardiff

We are planning to take **Year 4** to **Techniquet** in Cardiff on **19th December 2024**.

Techniquet provides a unique learning experience through interactive engagement with science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM). With hands-on exhibits and puzzles, as well as areas that address issues in our environment, children will have plenty of self-led discovery activities to entertain them.

This ties in well with our current topic of looking at a number of famous scientists and inventors, and we hope it will inspire the children to look at ways of continuing to better our planet through the use of STEM.

The coach will leave School on the morning of **19.12.24** promptly at **08:00am** and should be back at School by 15:00pm. Children can therefore be **collected as normal** from their classroom, fire exit doors. This gives us chance to re-home any loose items found on the bus at the end of the trip and send to clubs accordingly.

The total cost of the trip (including coach travel) per pupil is **£16.00**.

All children should wear full School Uniform and will need to bring the following:
