FUNDRAISING & THANKS



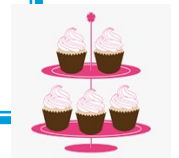

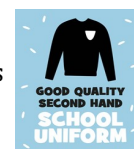
School Uniform and Second Hand Uniform
