


If your child is a pupil in Reception or Year 6 then you should have received a letter from the NHS inviting them to take part in the National Child Measurement Programme.

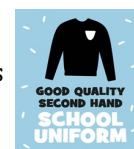
School Uniform and Second Hand Uniform
